Competition status

During 2021 when pandemic continues, Council agreed that General Competition Rules (GCR) minimum requirements of participation countries and teams will be not followed concerning upcoming Moscow and Sofia events.

Minimum 4 countries / category (women and juniors) must have done and fulfill definitive registrations (including participation fee for LOC) according to the due date, that the status of each competition will stay (European Championships, World Cup, Challenge Cup and IFAGG Championships).
