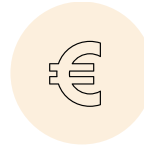

LOC World Gymnaestrada 2023 Amsterdam strongly advises a cashless approach due to safety concerns.

RAI Card:

- There will be a sales point at the RAI grounds during the World Gymnaestrada 2023 Amsterdam .
- You can choose a cash value of 5, 10, 15 or 25 euro per card.
- The RAI Card can be purchased with cash and pin at the sales point on location.
- The RAI Card can only be used to pay at the RAI's public catering outlets. You cannot use the card to pay for merchandise, tickets or other social program activities.
- The RAI Card cannot be upgraded. Empty = Empty.
- It is possible to pay with several RAI Cards if, for example, there is still a residual value on one RAI Card, but it does not have sufficient balance for the items to be purchased. This can then be replenished with a new RAI Card.
- Please note that any remaining balance cannot be refunded.

Important notes:

- In the Netherlands, you can use your debit card to make payments everywhere; it's the norm. Credit cards are not accepted everywhere, especially in most stores. For example, cash payments are not possible in public transportation. Payments can only be made with euros.
- WG2023 strongly advises a cashless approach due to safety concerns. However, based on feedback from participants, it is not feasible for some of them. Therefore, we are forced to tolerate cash but do not encourage its use. Cash will be accepted at fixed points of sale.
- Amsterdam is a large city, and carrying cash poses risks when dealing with large crowds. It attracts unwanted attention. We recommend that the Head of Delegation (HoD) organize a safe or similar facility at each accommodation location where valuable documents can be stored. Avoid carrying large amounts of cash on the street.
- Local Organizing Committee (LOC) takes no responsibility for the loss or theft of money during your stay in the Netherlands.
