Dear friends of TeamGym,

We are pleased to give you the following information regarding the definitive registration:

1. Status provisional registration

The status regarding provisional registration, number of teams from each country in each section. According to bullet 4.4 in the Nordic TeamGym Championships Technical regulations (Nordic TR) there was an option to sign up three teams in the mix section.

2. Venue

The competition will take place in Laugardalshöll, Engjavegi 8, 104 Reykjavík. The hotels will be located near the venue with a walking distance of 650 m to 1.3 km. Therefore, no transport will be needed apart from transport from Keflavík Airport.



3. Equipment

We have an exclusive agreement with **PE-Redskaber A/S** that ensures an identical equipment setup in both training -, and competition hall.

Floor

Dimensions of the competition area: 16 m x 14 m x 0,35 m Borderline: 5 cm white Velcro.

The mats are connected side by side with blue velcro on top, the connections will be in the short side.

Tumble

Run up: 16 m consisting of 8 blocks of 2 m x 1 m x 0,33 m. Tumple track: 15 m x 2 m PE-Redskaber. Safety Strips for Tumble track: 200 x 50 x 33 cm. There will be placed two pices on each side. Velcro on all sides.

Landing area: A total area of 4 m x 7 m, with additional safety mat.

Trampet

Run up: Two separate roll mats (one for trampet without vault and one for trampet with vault).

Vaulting table: model "Tarpan", can be adjusted in height from 110 cm to 165 cm at an interval of 5 cm.

Trampets: "Dorado 36 TeamGym" with 36 springs and "Dorado 40 TeamGym" with 40 springs. Front protection, adjustable from 65-80 cm in increments of 5 cm

Landing area: 7 m x 7 m x 33 cm with two separate landing zones, with additional safety mat.

4. Competition format

The competition will be organised according to:

- A. Nordic TeamGym Championship Technical Regulations
- **B.** EGs Code of Points and appendices, and Nordic TeamGym Championships Technical Regulations
- **C.** EGs Directives for Equipment and appendices, and Nordic TeamGym Championships Technical Regulations
- **D.** The rules of the statues of EG will be applied in all situations, which are not foreseen in these regulations. If extraordinary situations should occur, the necessary decisions will be made by the NTC-TG or the representatives of each country present at the competition.
- **E.** The statutes and regulations of the FIG are valid in all matters of protocol.

6. Size of the delegations

According to the technical regulations art. 4.4:

- Maximum 2 teams per section (men, women, and mixed).
- Maximum 3 coaches per team.
- Maximum 14 gymnasts including reserves per team.
- Maximum 1 Team Leader per team.
- Maximum 4 judges.
- Maximum 2 physiotherapists/doctors or similar function.
- 1 Head of the delegation.
- 1 Deputy Head of the delegation.
- 1 Media/press (representing the federation).
- Maximum 2 national coaches.
- 1 NTC-TG member.

7. Age of the participants

Seniors: Minimum 16 years. The gymnasts have the right to participate if they reach the determined min age during the year of the competition.

8. Responsibility for the National federations

The national federations (NF) are responsible for:

- The correct age of their gymnasts.
- The club membership of their gymnasts.
- Valid insurance of their gymnasts.
- That their teams follow the EG rules for advertising.

8.1 Please bring the following for accreditation:

- Passport or another kind of identification card with a photo
- Valid insurance certificate
- Proof of payment

9. Airport transfer

Reykjavík is located in an approximately 40 min drive from Keflavík Airport, KEF. Airport transfer to and from the hotel is included in the accommodation package.

10. Accommodation

Hotel prices <u>are per person for three nights and include full board</u> (from Thursday until Sunday).

The accommodation package will include:

- Hotel for 3 nights (Thursday Sunday). Breakfast included
- Lunch Friday and Saturday
- Dinner Thursday and Friday
- Airport transfer

Banquet is not included in this package and will be sold separately.

Each team requests a hotel category. LOC will allocate hotels within the category requested. A limited number of rooms are available at each hotel. Reservations and category preference will be served on a "first come, first served" basis. Once Member Federations have submitted their Category preference, the LOC will either:

• assign a hotel according to the request (i.e., if still available), or

• directly contact the Federation to discuss alternative options in case the booking request cannot be fulfilled due to the Category being already fully allocated.
