4 Venue

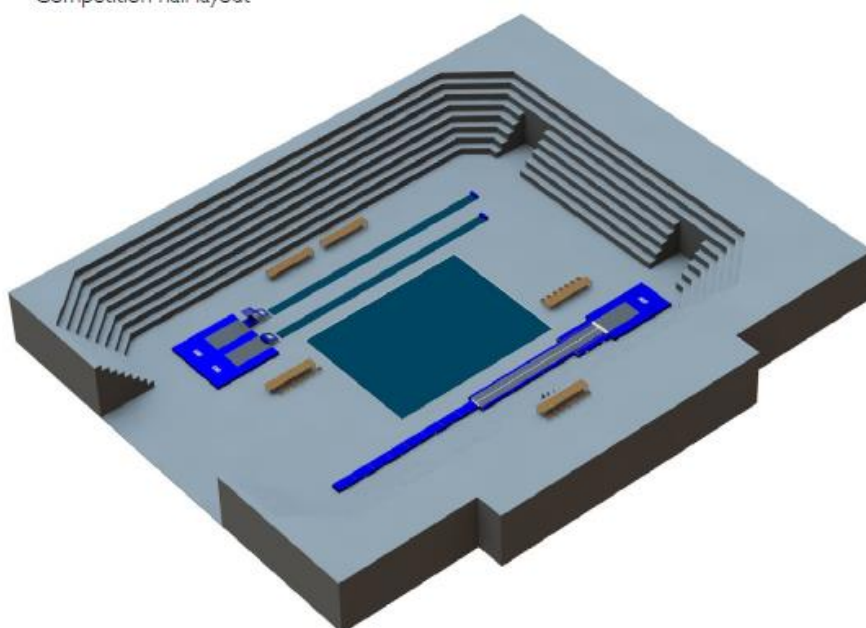
Sparbanken Skåne Arena, Stattenavägen 25, 222 28 Lund.

The training and competition arena is situated in the southern part of Lund, in the district Klostergården, a 5-minute walk from the Lund Klostergården station, and a 15-minute walk from Lund city and Lund central railway station. The hotels will be located in the centre of Lund and within a 4 km radius around the arena. Transportation from the hotels to the competition arena will be provided, read more in section 5.2.

5 Transport

5.1 Airport/train station information and transportation

Delegates are responsible for arranging their own transport to Lund. The nearest international airport is Malmö Airport, located 30 km from Lund. It is also possible to fly to Copenhagen airport (CPH), and then continue via the Öresund bridge by train or bus. No transfer will be arranged from the airports or train stations.

5.2 Bus transport

There will be special shuttle busses between the hotels and the competition arena Friday and Saturday and to and from the banquet at Hotel Scandic Star Lund.

See appendix 3 for transports. Deadline for sending in the transport list is the 31st of March.

You will receive a final time table no later than the 4th of April.

Pick up point at Sparbanken Skåne Arena across the bridge over Ringvägen, outside the parking lot Arena Park.

6 Equipment

We will provide competition equipment according to the Nordic TeamGym Championships Technical Regulations. The competition equipment will be delivered from Unisport. See information in Appendix 1.

6.1 Equipment set up

You will receive the equipment set up form at the accreditation. Please fill in the form for equipment set up and leave the form to the equipment staff no later then at the end of warm-up. Leave the form to the equipment staff.

7 Competition

7.1 Competition format

- The competition rules will be according to the Nordic TeamGym Championships Technical Regulations 2024.
- Nordic setup, warm up and competition in the same hall.

7.2 Running order

The draw for starting order took place in Stockholm on February 23. The draw was approved by Sofia Svegander, the Swedish member of NTC-TG. See Appendix 2.

7.3 Warm-up

The teams general warm-up is in Hall B. There are no TeamGym apparatus in the warm-up area except a floor area shared by all teams. Training on the apparatus takes place on the Field of Play according to the training schedule.

7.4 Tariff and music

Every nation will be sent information separately from trupp@gymnastik.se with information about Tariff and login details. In Tariff you will upload tariff forms and music.

Upload music no later than 10th of April.

Upload tariff forms no later than two hours before competition starts.

7.5 National anthem

The short version of your national anthem is to be uploaded to Tariff no later than 10th of April by each country's federation.

7.6 Opening ceremony and award ceremony

At the opening ceremony, the countries and the teams will be presented. The teams will be announced by country. Participants must march in wearing club uniform. The gymnasts will walk across the floor area. When the opening speech is finished, the teams march out, and the first competing Junior Mixed team will soon after start their competition. After the final warm-up of the Junior Mix Section, a short opening show, arranged by the LOC will take place.

The award ceremony will take place on Saturday after all three competitions. Only the medal winning teams will march in. We will meet up in hall B. Please ensure that your Federation's medallists are in time for the line-up before the award ceremony.

7.7 Field of play

Please note that the use of mobile phones or any other electronic communication device by gymnasts, coaches, judges or medical staff of the delegations on the field of play is forbidden during the entire duration of the competitions.

7.8 Competition jury

According to the technical regulations 9.5:

The competition jury consists of:

- NTC-TG (one representative from each of the Nordic countries)
- The competition director
- The head judge (E1) in the respective discipline

The NTC-TG will take the necessary decisions.

An NTC-TG member not able to attend the jury can appoint a new person from the same country to be part of the jury. The OC and NTC-TG must receive this information as soon as possible. It is allowed at the Nordic Championships for a judge to be both judge and NTC-TG-member.

7.9 Inquiries

According to the technical regulations art. 9.6:

Inquiries are not used at the Nordic Championships.

7.10 Dissensions and interpretations of the CoP

According to the technical regulations art. 9.4:

If there is any dissension between the judges at the judges' meeting when it comes to the interpretation of the Code of Points, the case will be settled by simple majority vote by the NTC-TG. All judges are obliged to follow these decisions.

It is still the head judge in the respective disciplines who's responsible for making interpretation and decisions regarding other issues in the Code of Points during the competition.

For the Nordic Junior Championship in Sweden 2024 the Nordic Technical Committee has decided that §1 and §2 regarding dynamic execution and standing balance WILL BE applied

but §3 regarding twisting leaps/hops WILL NOT be applied. [More information here.](#)
This because of the short amount of time the teams will have until April to change their floor performance.

7.11 Medical

Paramedics will be available in the competition arena both Friday and Saturday. A specialist in orthopaedics will be available both days for immediate evaluation in case of injury. We request you to bring your own icepacks and sports tapes so the ice and tape we have is purely for immediate injuries.

There will be a meeting for all Physios Friday 12:45-13:00 in hall B.

8 Responsibility for the National Federations

The national federations (NF) are responsible for:

- The correct age of their gymnasts.
- The club membership of their gymnasts.
- Valid insurance of their gymnasts.
- That their teams follow the EG rules for advertising.

Please bring the following for accreditation:

- Passport or another kind of identification card with a photo
- Valid insurance certificate
- Proof of payment
- Accreditation and insurance

8.1 Age of participants

According to the technical regulations 4.2:

For the junior TeamGym: 14 - 17 years

The gymnasts have the right to participate if they reach the determined min/max age during the year of the competition.

8.2 Composition of the teams

According to the technical regulations 4.1:

8-14 gymnasts including any reserves, from the same club (an exception can be made and the gymnasts can come from a max. of two clubs, but the team must have competed together in the competition year). Each team has to announce the competitors and reserves at the accreditation. A gymnast can only represent one club, but is allowed to participate in both mixed and men/women.

8.3 Numbering of gymnasts

Numbering of gymnasts is mandatory and must comply with the Code of Points used for this competition. Fill in the numbers in nominative registration.

8.4 National identification or emblem

According to technical regulations 18.1:

Wearing a national identification or emblem is optional at the Nordic TeamGym Championships (see CoP 4.2.1 and 8.2)

8.5 Accreditation and accreditation pass

Accreditation will take place at Sparbanken Skåne Arena on Friday 19th of April from 10:00 to 18:00. Only the Head of Delegation/Deputy Head of Delegation can carry out the accreditation for each country. More information will come in a separate email regarding time booking for accreditation.

The correct age and valid insurance will be checked at the accreditation. Bring passport or other valid identification card with photo.

Juniors 14-17 years. The correct age will be checked.

All delegations must bring a valid written confirmation regarding health and accident insurance at the accreditation. This insurance must cover all official members of the delegation, both gymnasts and officials.

All official delegation members will receive an accreditation pass. The accreditation pass is personal and non-transferable. The accreditation pass is compulsory to get access to the competition venue.

Replacing a lost accreditation pass will cost SEK 400.

8.6 Access to the competition area

Access to the competition area (as stated in the accreditation pass) is permitted only to gymnasts, coaches, judges, technical assistants, competition's medical staff and the organizing committee. Everyone in the official delegation will have an accreditation pass, which must be shown when entering controlled areas.

8.7 Seats for delegation members and gymnasts

Reserved seats will be available for the Head of Delegation, deputy Head of Delegation, judges, and members of Nordic Technical Committee in the competition hall.

Seats for gymnasts and coaches will be available in the competition hall on the short end side. The accreditation pass gives you access to the assigned seating area.

8.8 Insurance

Read more about this in Responsibility for the National Federations and Accreditation and Accreditation pass.

8.9 Clothing during practice

During all practice in the competition hall, a similar, neat and proper athletic appearance should be the overall impression of the teams. For more information, please read the Technical Regulations for the Nordic TeamGym Championships.

8.10 EG publicity

According to technical regulations 18.3: *EG rules for advertisement are followed.*

9 Alterations

9.1 Alterations of the teams

According to the technical regulations 5.3:

Alterations of the teams are possible only in exceptional cases and must be authorised by NTC-TG. Alterations will not be accepted later than at the accreditation.

9.2 Alteration of the nominative lists of gymnasts

According to the technical regulations 5.4:

Before accreditation teams are allowed to change/replace nominated gymnasts without any further action, except changes must be handed in to the OC at the accreditation. After accreditation, and before the start of the competition, changes to the nominative list are only allowed between the registered competing gymnasts and the registered reserve gymnasts. All alterations must be handed in to the OC.

9.3 In case of illness or injury during the competition

According to the technical regulations 5.5:

In cases of illness or injury during the competition, confirmed by the official doctor of the championships, it is allowed to replace the affected gymnast with a nominated reserve.

Replacing an injured or ill gymnast is optional, but gymnast needs to be excused by the competition doctor.

10 Meetings

Information meeting

The information meeting for Head of Delegations, Deputy Head of Delegations, one coach per team and judges on Friday at 20:00. The meeting will take place in Glasbollen at Sparbanken Skåne Arena.

Chair of the Swedish Technical Committee Sofia Svegander will lead the meeting together with competition director Alessia Bommarco.

10.1 Judges meetings

According to the technical regulations art. 9.3:

All judges must participate at the judges meeting prior to the competition. Tariff forms will be distributed to the judges on the evening prior to the competition day.

11 Meals and Banquet

All meals, except for dinner on Thursday will be served at the competition arena in Krafrtingen Lounge on the 1st floor. We will send a schedule for all meals because of limited space in the lounge.

Dinner Thursday: Not included in the accommodation package (LOC can arrange dinner at the hotel if requested).

Lunch Friday: Beef patty with pickled cucumber, pepper sauce and parsley potatoes.

Dinner Friday: Roasted chicken breast with herb roasted potatoes, chipotle gravy, coleslaw and tarragon emulsion.

Lunch Saturday: Pasta Bolognese, bread, butter and raw food salad
(All competitors in the women's competition will be served a food package. It can be collected by one person per team in Krafrtingen Lounge between 11:00-14:15).

All meals include beverage and salad.

Banquet Saturday: Buffé with non alcoholic drinks included. No alcohol will be served. There will be entertainment and transportation back to the hotels from Scandic Star hotel at 00:00-00:15.

Competition and alcohol does not go well together and Swedish Gymnastics follow Riksidrottsförbundets (Swedish Sports Confederation) policy regarding this matter. [Read the policy here](#). The minimum age for alcohol consumption in Sweden is 18 years according to Swedish law. The delegations are responsible for the proper behaviour of their participants. If any under age participant is under the influence of alcohol, they will be banned from the banquet.

If someone within the delegation has special needs regarding food – e.g. vegetarian, vegan, allergies, etc. please make a special note on the registration form in the nominative registration.

Note! Remember to bring your accreditation pass.

12.2 No bags are allowed

Due to new regulations introduced by the police in Sweden, members of the audience are not allowed to bring any bags into the arena. All kinds of bags are covered by the ban except bags for medical reasons or diaper bags for children.

However, coaches and gymnasts are permitted to bring their bags to the arena. We kindly request your assistance in spreading this information to any potential audience members from your countries.

The bags you bring in to the arena must be stored in the changing rooms. This applies for the entire delegation.

Information about equipment for the Junior Nordic TeamGym Championships.

FLOOR

Floor: LEG

Size: 16x14 m, H: 35 mm

Color: Light blue

LEG the TeamGym floor program is performed on 8 mats in the size 14x2 m, H: 35 mm with non-slip protection underneath.

All carpet mats are connected with 10 cm wide Velcro strips.

The competition area is 16x14 m and is marked with 5 cm wide white Velcro that is included in the competition area.

TUMBLE

Tumble: LEG

1 set Approach run-up: LEG

Size: 16x1 m, H: 350 mm

Color: Light blue

The approach run-up consists of 8 podium sections 2x1 m with a light blue needle felt mat on top of 16x1 m. A 31m tape measure will be attached to the floor at the side of the run-up.

1 set Tumble track: LEG model "Reykjavik"

Size: 15x2 m, H: 350 mm

Color: Dark blue side part and black mesh cover on top.

LEG tumble track consists of 15 steel sections 2x1 m with 18 fiberglass rods per section.

A carpet pad, 15x2 m, H: 35 mm with the needle felt facing downwards towards the fiberglass rods.

An E.V.A-foam mat, 15x2 m, H: 60 mm on top of the needle felt mat.

At the top is our elastic net which is attached with velcro to the approach block and with a flap to the landing mat.

4 pcs Side protection LEG

Size: 2x0.5 m, H: 350 mm

Color: Dark blue

The side protection consists of hard foam content and has a size of 2x0.5 m, H: 350 mm. Which gives the coach a more stable platform should he/she be forced to act.

1 set Landing area for tumble floor: LEG

Size: 7x4 m, H: 350 mm

Colour: Dark blue with gray landing zone 3x1.5m

The landing area consists of 3 impact mats 4000x2000x300 mm that are laid crosswise one after the other. On top there is a 4-part damping mat in the size 6000x4000x50 mm with a marked landing zone in gray color 3x1.5m.

The connection between the tumble track and the damping mat consists of a 300 mm wide white Velcro flap.

Behind the landing area is an extra safety mat 4000x1000x350 mm.

1 extra safety mat: LEG

Size: 4x2 m, H: 100 mm

Colour: Grey/Dark blue with elastic fabric on top and grey landing zone 3x1.5 m.

TRAMPET

2 pcs approach run-up (one approach run-up to the trampet and one to the vault) LEG:

Size: 25x1 m, H: 25 mm

Color: Light blue

The approach mat consists of a needle felt mat with non-slip protection underneath.

2 x 25 m stops

Size: 1 m

Color: Dark blue

A tape measure will be attached to the floor between the two run-ups.

2 pcs 25 m stops:

Size: 1 m

Color: Dark blue

1 vaulting table Tarpan:

Size: According to European Gymnastics rules H: 110-165 cm

Color: Dark blue and gray.

Trampet:

2 pc Dorado-32

Size: According to European Gymnastics regulations H: 65-80 cm (high part)

Colour: White canvas with a marking in the middle and with black safety cover and permanently mounted protection pad.

Attention! The protection pad must not be removed during vault, it must remain on the trampet during the entire performance.

2 pc Dorado-36

Size: According to European Gymnastics regulations H: 65-80 cm (high part)

Colour: Yellow canvas with marking in the middle and with black safety cover and permanently mounted protection pad.

Attention! The protection pad must not be removed during vault, it must remain on the trampet during the entire performance.

2 pc Dorado-40

Size: According to European Gymnastics regulations H: 65-80 cm (high part)

Colour: Red canvas with marking in the middle and with black safety cover and permanently mounted protection pad.

Attention! The protection pad must not be removed during vault, it must remain on the trampet during the entire performance.

1 set Double landing area for trampet: LEG

Size: 7x7 m, H: 350 mm

Colour: Dark blue with 2 gray landing zones 3x1.5 m

The landing area consists of 6 impact mats 3500x2000x300 mm, which are laid 3 across each other in 2 "lines" next to each other for vault and trampet on its own. On top there are 2 sets of 4-part damping mat in size 6000x3500x50 mm with marked landing zone in gray color 3x1.5 m.

Behind the landing area are two additional safety mats 4000x1000x350 mm next to each other.

1 extra safety mat: LEG

Size: 4x2 m, H: 100 mm

Colour: Grey/Dark blue with elastic fabric on top and gray landing zone 3x1.5 m
