



**Åland 8th-10th of May 2026**

*Welcome to a competition on the Åland Islands!*

*We are excited to invite you all to the 8th Åland International. This time offering prize money for the winners in the WAG CoP division.*



**Organiser: Gymnastics Åland r.f.**

**Date: Friday 8th - Sunday 10th of May 2026**

**Place: GymnastikArena Åland, Verkaregränd 2, 22120 Mariehamn**

**Competition format:** WAG Easy rules (younger and older division) and WAG CoP rules (normal Code of Points). The all around finals and qualifications to the event finals will be held on Friday (WAG Easy) and Saturday (WAG CoP). The event finals will take place on Sunday. The top six gymnasts on each apparatus from each competition and age group will make it to the event finals. Team competition separate for WAG Easy and WAG CoP. More details to follow in PM1. We accept 10 gymnasts in the WAG Easy division and 10 gymnasts in the WAG CoP division per club. If more gymnasts from one club wish to attend, they will be placed on a waiting list up until the last registration date.

There will be prize money for the winners in the WAG CoP all around competition for seniors (500€) and juniors (200€).

**Competition rules:** Attached below.

**Competition Fee:** 60€ per gymnast

**Insurance:** All competitors must have valid insurance for competition.

**Apparatus:** Gymnova vault (FIG approved), Gymnova bars (FIG approved), Gymnova balance beam (FIG approved), Diony sprung floor (FIG approved).

**Judges:** 1 judge / 1-6 gymnasts per competition format (WAG Easy/WAG CoP). The judges need to have successfully completed a national level judges course. The penalty for not bringing a judge is 250€ for each competition format. We will prioritize clubs bringing a judge. Judges need to be available both for AA and finals.

Registration opens on the 1st of October. Deadline two months before, on the 8th of March. Late registrations will be charged a double fee.

# COMPETITION RULES ÅLAND INTERNATIONAL 8-10.5 2026

## WAG Easy Rules

The Easy FIG competitors will be divided into a younger and older division. Separate finals for the different age groups. Gymnasts born 2011 and earlier will make the older division and gymnasts born 2012-2016 will make the younger division.

Only A-, B- and C-elements from CoP to make up DV. Elements above C-value will have a value of 0.3. No extra points for CV (connection values). Execution score as per CoP.

### VAULT

FIG vaulting table with springs, height 115 or 125 cm (WAG Easy younger) and 125 cm (WAG Easy older). In order to qualify for apparatus finals, gymnasts need to perform 2 vaults.

- The two vaults must have different vault numbers
- The first vault will be for the individual overall title. The second vault will be averaged with the first vault for the apparatus medals.
- Vault tariffs will be taken from the code of points at time of competition.

### UNEVEN BARS

FIG bars set up. The gymnast is allowed to use a springboard for mounts.

Short routine deductions: 8-6 elements = no deduction. 5 elements = -2,0 points. 4 elements = -3,0 points. 3 elements = -4,0 points. 2 elements = -5,0 points. 1 element = -6,0 points.

### CR

• Element to/through handstand	0.5
• Circle element with B-value	0.5
• Another circle element from the code	0.5
• Dismount containing a salto	0.5

### BEAM

Beam set up according to FIG rules. The gymnast is allowed to use a springboard for mounts.

All CR must be performed on the beam (not as mounts or dismounts).

- Combination of two gymnastic leaps or jumps, with at least one leap/jump showing split 0.5.
- A turn, roll or flare from the CoP (group 3) 0.5.
- A combination of two acrobatic elements one being a flight element (same or different) 0.5.
- Acrobatic elements on the beam forward/sideways and backwards 0.5.

### FLOOR

The routine is performed on a 12x12 m floor. The routine is performed to music.

CR

- A dance passage with at least one of the leaps showing split 0.5
- An acrobatic combination of at least two flight elements, one being a salto with at least B-value 0.5
- An acrobatic combination of at least two flight elements, one being a salto forward. 0.5
- An acrobatic combination of at least two flight elements, one being a salto backward. 0.5

## **WAG CoP Rules**

The FIG competitors will be divided into juniors (born 2011-2015) and seniors (born 2010 and earlier). Separate finals for juniors and seniors.

The rules will be based on the Fédération Internationale de Gymnastiques WAG Code of Points 2025-2028.
